This deli-style café, which opened in 2010, was inspired in part by New York's Dean & DeLuca, and comes with canteen-style decor by Barcelona-based architects GCA and branding by graphics studio The Own. It makes an interesting change from the countless bars in the city that can only offer up a coffee and croissant in the morning: order a freshly squeezed juice or *batido* (smoothie), or choose from a

selection of bread and muffins. You could also put together a picnic-style lunch to go, with sandwiches and gourmet baked goods, salads, pasta and rice, farmhouse cheeses and even fresh oysters available to eat in or take away.
